AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION

Petition for amendment of certification was filed with the Public Employment Relations Board by General Drivers and Helpers Union, Local No. 421, seeking to amend its certification as the representative of this bargaining unit of employees of Jackson County. The petition proposes that the certification be amended to reflect Local 421's merger into Teamsters Local Union No. 120.

A public notice of PERB's proposed decision to grant the requested amendment was issued and posted in accordance with PERB's rules. No objections to the proposed decision have been filed within the time specified in that notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the certification of the General Drivers and Helpers Union, Local No. 421 as the exclusive bargaining representative for certain employees of Jackson County issued in PERB Case No. 67 is hereby amended so

that the certified representative will hereafter be identified
as TEAMSTERS LOCAL UNION NO. 120.

ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 8th day of October, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on September 24, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that General Drivers and Helpers Union, Local No. 421 an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that General Drivers and Helpers Union Local No. 421 should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Jackson County a public employer, in the following bargaining unit:

INCLUDED: All employees of Jackson County road Department including shop foremen, equipment operator III, equipment operator II, equipment operator I, mechanic and sign men.

EXCLUDED: County engineer, assistant county engineer, maintenance superintendent, professional employee, office clerical employees, road foremen and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
