ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition duly filed in accordance with Iowa Code section 20.14 and PERB rule, a representative certification election was conducted herein under the direction and supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the valid ballots were cast in favor of the affected bargaining unit's representation by General Drivers and Helpers Union, Local 554, that no objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15 and PERB rule, and that the employee organization has complied with the relevant requirements of Iowa Code section 20.25.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that General Drivers and Helpers Union, Local 554 is hereby designated and certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of Monona County:

INCLUDED: Deputy Sheriffs, Clerks in the Sheriff's Office and Dispatchers, Jailers and Dispatcher/Jailers.

EXCLUDED: All other employees of the County.

**ORDER OF DECERTIFICATION**

Pursuant to a timely petition filed under §15.6 of the Public Employment Relations Act and Rule 4.3 of the Rules of the Public Employment Relations Board [PERB], a decertification election was conducted on January 25, 2000. In that election, unresolved challenges were sufficient in number to affect the results of the election. The parties were subsequently able to resolve the challenge to the voting eligibility of four employees. On February 2, 2000, the Board ordered a new ballot count to be conducted. On February 2, 2000, a new ballot count, which included the, now resolved, challenged ballots, was conducted and a substituted tally of ballots was served upon the parties to this proceeding. Pursuant to the results of that substituted tally, a majority of the employees in the appropriate unit voted that they no longer wished to be represented by Communications Workers of America. No objections to the election were filed within the time provided by PERB Rule 5.4(2).

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Communications Workers of America, be decertified as the exclusive bargaining representative, and that no organization is the exclusive representative, in the following unit, previously determined in Case No. 2316.

**INCLUDED:** All employees of the Monona County, City of Onawa Service Agency including all communications operators/dispatcher/Clerks.

**EXCLUDED:** All supervisors and those excluded by Section 4 of the Act.


