ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

The Public Employment Relations Board [Board or PERB] has been advised that an election was conducted pursuant to Order of the Board; that a majority of the ballots were cast for Webster County Secondary Road Employees Association, an employee organization; that no objections to the election have been filed, and that said employee organization has complied with all requirements of the Public Employment Relations Act, Chapter 20, Code of Iowa (1999) and the Rules thereunder:

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Webster County Secondary Road Employees Association, should be, and hereby is, designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for employees of Webster County, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit:

**INCLUDED:** All regular full-time employees of the Webster County Secondary Road Department, including all regular full-time Equipment Operators, Mechanics, Sign Technicians, Welder/Fabricators, and Part/Purchasing Agents.

**EXCLUDED:** Engineer, Assistant Engineer, Assistant to the Engineer, Maintenance Superintendent, Engineering Technician, Foreman, clerical employees, Office Administrator, Secretary, supervisory employees, confidential employees, temporary employees and all others excluded by the Act.
