AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed under Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act and Rule 4 6 of the Public Employment Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, the parties waived hearing and filed with the Public Employment Relations Board stipulation of bargaining unit excluding the job classification of Assistant Wastewater Department Supervisor from the previously determined bargaining unit

Said stipulation having been tentatively approved by the Board and the Board having no objections,

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the bargaining unit previously determined in case number 158 and the certification of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, in that case be and hereby are amended to read as follows

INCLUDED All employees and working formen of the Streets, Waste Water, Parks, Water and Vehicle Maintenance Departments.

EXCLUDED Professional employees, office clerical employees, supervisors, all employees of other departments of the City, Assistant Wastewater Department Supervisor and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act
