AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed under Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act [Act], Chapter 20, Iowa Code (1991) and Rule 4.6 of the Public Employment Relations Board [Board or PERB], the parties filed with the Board a Stipulation of Bargaining Unit. Said Stipulation was tentatively approved by the Board; a Public Notice of Proposed Decision of Amendment of Bargaining Unit was posted in conformance with PERB Rules, and no objections were filed, therefore:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the bargaining unit previously determined in Case No 471, and the certification of 471, is amended to read as follows:

INCLUDED: All sworn Police Officers and Secretaries-Matrons of the Cherokee Police Department.

EXCLUDED: Chief of Police, Captain, Lieutenant of the Cherokee Police Department and all other employees of the City of Cherokee, Iowa

EXCLUDED: Chief of police, captain, lieutenant, and all other employees of the City of Cherokee and those excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
