
ORDER

EXCLUDED: All other employees of the City of Coralville including the Parks Superintendent, Superintendent of Public Works, Assistant to the Public Works Director, Public Works Director, Parks & Recreation Department Director, City Engineer, Superintendent of Wastewater Treatment Plant, Superintendent of Water Department and Recreation Administrative Assistant, confidential employees, and all other employees excluded by by Section 4 of the Act.
