Based upon our review of the entire record, we find that hearing officer correctly determined that the positions of sergeant and identification officer are not excluded from coverage of the Act as "supervisory employees" as defined in Section 4.2 of the Act. Further, that the parties have agreed that the positions of corporal is not supervisory in nature and should be included in the bargaining unit. It is therefore ordered that the following constitutes an appropriate bargaining unit:

INCLUDED: All police officers, master police officer,

detective, corporal, identification officer

and sergeant.

EXCLUDED: Police chief, police captain and all other

non-sworn personnel of the police department and all other persons excluded by Section 4

of the Act.
