AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20 13 and PERB rule 621-4 6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the City of Johnston initially determined in PERB Case No 4818, and the certification of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees/Iowa Council 61, is amended to provide

INCLUDED Mechanic, Maintenance Worker, Maintenance Worker II Crew Leader, Public Works Secretary

EXCLUDED Supervisors, Department Heads, Accounting Clerk, all others excluded by the Act, and youth workers (program) hired for less than six months between the months of April and September each year


