AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed under Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act [Act], Chapter 20, Iowa Code (1997) and Rule 4.6 of the Public Employment Relations Board [Board or PERB], the parties filed with the Board a Stipulation of Bargaining Unit. Said Stipulation was tentatively approved by the Board; a Public Notice of Proposed Decision of Amendment of Bargaining Unit was posted in conformance with PERB Rules; and no objections were filed, therefore:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit previously determined in Case No. 3506, and the certification of Public Professional & Maintenance Employees, Local #2003, is amended to read as follows:

INCLUDED: All employees in the Engineering, Street, and Utility Divisions of the Public Works Department and the Sewer Division of the Water Pollution Control Plant.

EXCLUDED: All Clerical, Supervisory, Professional, Confidential, and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act.


