Now on this 13th day of May, 1976, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on April 27, 1976, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that Municipal Laborers Local #353, an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Municipal Laborers Local #353

should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of the City of Urbandale, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED Employees of the Street, Solid Waste, Waste Water and Parks departments in the following classifications Laborer, Custodian, Plant Operator, Collector, driver/collector, light equipment operator, heavy equipment operator and mechanic

EXCLUDED All professional, all office and clerical and all supervisory employees including the Director of Public Works, the Superintendent of Public Works, the Parks Director, the Superintendent of Recreation and Aquatics, the Waste Water Supervisor, the Parks Foreman, Street and Solid Waste Foremen, all other city employees and all those excluded by Section 4 of the Act
