### RECOMMENDED DECISION AND ORDER

### FINDINGS OF FACT

Larry Sivesind (hereinafter Petitioner) filed an Amendment of Unit petition with the Public Employment Relations Board (hereinafter Board) on March 31, 1982. That petition sought to include a Sanitation Utility Person from the Health and Sanitation Department in a unit determined in Case No. 43, amended in Case Nos. 583 and 1661 and represented by Municipal Employees Local Union 1127 (hereinafter Municipal Employees). The petition stated that the employee was presently represented by Teamsters Local 844 (hereinafter Teamsters).

Hearing was scheduled on this petition on May 17, 1982. At this hearing the City of Waterloo (hereinafter City) and the Teamsters indicated they would have no objection to the Board's inclusion of the involved Sanitation Utility Person in the unit represented by the Municipal Employees after the Petitioner filed a statement with the Board changing his petition to a unit clarification petition. The Municipal Employees filed a statement with the Board on May 18, 1982 indicating that they would not intervene in this action, but would accept the Petitioner as a member should the Board decide to amend the unit.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

All parties involved in this case have indicated their lack of opposition to the Sanitation Utility Person in the Health and Sanitation Department becoming part of the unit represented by the Municipal Employees. I also have no objection to clarifying the units in this manner. Based upon the foregoing I issue the following recommended order:

### ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the unit established in Case No. 18 and amended in Case No. 2195 be clarified to exclude the Sanitation Utility Person in the Health and Sanitation Department.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the unit established in Case No. 43 and amended in Case Nos. 583 and 1661 be clarified to include the Sanitation Utility Person in the Health and Sanitation Department.

### RECOMMENDED DECISION

### FINDINGS OF FACT

Roseann Cory, Anna Hamman, John Van Kamen and Karen Boesenberg (hereinafter Petitioners) filed an Amendment of Unit petition with the Public Employment Relations Board (hereinafter Board) on March 8, 1982. That petition sought to include Laboratory Technicians at Waterloo Pollution Control Plan and Milk Sanitation Dept. in a unit determined in Case No. 43, amended in Case Nos. 583 and 1661 and represented by Municipal Employees Local Union 1127 (hereinafter Municipal Employees). The petition stated that the employees were presently represented by Teamsters Local 844 (hereinafter Teamsters).

Hearing was scheduled on this petition on May 17, 1982. At this hearing the City of Waterloo (hereinafter City) and the Teamsters indicated they would have no objection to the Board's inclusion of the involved Laboratory Technicians in the unit represented by the Municipal Employees after the Petitioners filed a statement with the Board changing their petition to a unit clarification petition. The Municipal Employees filed a statement with the Board on May 18, 1982 indicating that they would not

intervene in this action, but would accept the Petitioners as members should the Board decide to amend the unit.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

All parties involved in this case have indicated their lack of opposition to the Laboratory Technicians in the Pollution Control Plant and the Milk Sanitation Dept. becoming part of the unit represented by the Municipal Employees. I also have no objection to clarifying the units in this matter. Based upon the foregoing I issue the following recommended order:

### ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the unit established in Case No. 18 and amended in Case No. 2195 be clarified to exclude Laboratory Technicians in the Pollution Control Plant and the Milk Sanitation Dept.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the unit established in Case No. 43 and amended in Case Nos. 583 and 1661 be clarified to include Laboratory Technicians in the Pollution Control Plant and the Milk Sanitation Dept.
