IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Webster City Association of Professional Fire Fighters, Local #1940 should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of the City of Webster City, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

EXCLUDED Fire Chief, assistant Chief, and all other
employees excluded by Section 4 of the Act
