PROPOSED DECISION AND ORDER

Charles E Boldt, Administrative Law Judge On July 25, 2000, the Over the Road and City Transfer Drivers, Local No 147 (Teamsters or Union) filed a petition for amendment of bargaining unit pursuant to Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act (Act), Chapter 20, Code of Iowa (1999), with the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) seeking to amend the positions of Dispatch Supervisor, Animal Control Officer, Jailer, Property Custodian, Evidence Technician, and Clerical Employees into the bargaining unit and remove the position of Humane Officer from the positions presently identified as included in a bargaining unit of employees of the City of West Des Moines (City or Employer) comprised of Patrol Officer, Dispatcher and Humane Officer

The City resisted the petition asserting that clerical employees either lacked a community of interest with other bargaining unit employees or were confidential employees under the Act and that the Dispatch Supervisor was a supervisory employee under the Act.

A hearing was conducted by the undersigned on September 28, The City was represented by James Hanks and the Union was represented by Dennis Francis Both parties had full opportunity services has had any responsibilities relating to collective bargaining. Additionally, the working relationship between the support services captain and the secretary for support services is not so close as to be preclusive to the inclusion of the position into the bargaining unit

I conclude that the secretary for support services is not a confidential employee pursuant to section 4 of the Act and is properly included in the bargaining unit as a clerical employee

For all the foregoing reasons, I issue the following recommended:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following constitutes an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining.

INCLUDED Police Officers, Dispatchers, Jailer, Civilian Property Officer, Animal Control Officer, Evidence Technician, and Clerical Employees

EXCLUDED Chief of Police, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, Dispatch Supervisor, Administrative Secretary to the Chief of Police, Administrative Assistant to the Chief's Executive Officer, and all those excluded by Section 4 of the Act
