Now on this 8th day of September, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on August 21, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that Ar-We-Va Education Association an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Ar-We-Va Education Association should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Ar-We-Va Community School District a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED Professional non-supervisory full-time and regular part-time classroom teachers, guidance counselor, librarian, remedial reading teachers working under Title I

EXCLUDED Superintendent, principals, all non-professional employees and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act
