AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20 15 and PERB rule 621-4 6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ordered that the bargaining unit initially determined in PERB Case No 92, and the certification of the Corning Community Education Association, is amended to read as follows

INCLUDED All full-time and regular part-time professional personnel, including classroom teachers, librarians, guidance director and nurses

EXCLUDED Superintendents, principals, athletic director, technology director, all non-professional employees, and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act
