AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

A combined petition for amendment of bargaining unit and amendment of certification was filed with the Public Employment Relations Board pursuant to PERB rules 621-4.6 and 621-4.8. The petition results from the reorganization of the Maple Valley Community School District and the Anthon-Oto Community School District into the Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Community School District effective July 1, 2012, the renaming of the Maple Valley Education Association as the Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Education Association, the elimination of the Anthon-Oto Education Association and the parties' desire to amend the description of the bargaining unit employed by the Maple Valley Community School District, into which employees of the Anthon-Oto Community School District are accreted pursuant to Iowa Code section 273.22(2), and which will thereafter be employed by the Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Community School District.

A public notice of PERB's proposed decision to grant the requested amendments was issued and posted in accordance with PERB rules. No objections to the proposed decision were filed within the time specified in such notice and the Maple Valley Education Association has complied with the relevant requirements of Iowa Code section 20.25.

THEREFORE IT ORDERED that the certification of the Maple Valley Education Association as the exclusive bargaining representative for certain employees of the Maple Valley Community School District, originally issued in PERB Case No. 2217 and subsequently amended in PERB Case No. 5435, is hereby amended to reflect its successor, the MAPLE VALLEY-ANTHON OTO EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, as the certified bargaining representative for the following-described unit of employees of the Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Community School District, the successor to Maple Valley Community School District and Anthon-Oto Community School District. The Anthon-Oto Education Association, certified in PERB Case No. 1718 and subsequently amended in PERB Case No. 2678, will no longer exist as the certified employee organization.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the description of the bargaining unit of employees of the Maple Valley Community School District, originally determined in PERB Case No. 2217 and subsequently amended in PERB Case No. 5435, and now represented by the Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Education Association, is amended to provide:

INCLUDED: All licensed teachers, school nurses and guidance counselors employed by Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Community School

District and the non-professional positions of bus drivers, principal's secretary, teacher aides, custodian, and part-time custodian previously employed by the Anthon-Oto Community School District and were part of its bargaining unit immediately prior to reorganization with the Maple Valley Community School District. Those non-professional positions will diminish over time as the persons currently in the positions leave employment with the newly reorganized Maple Valley-Anthon Oto Community School District or are no longer employed in the named positions.

EXCLUDED: Superintendent, principals, athletic director, substitutes and all other persons excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.
