ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 30th day of June, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on May 27, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that the Marshalltown Education Association,

an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that the MARSHALLTOWN EDUCATION ASSOCIATION should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of the Marshalltown Community School District, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED Duly certified classroom teachers, counselors, librarians, school nurses and special resource personnel

EXCLUDED Superintendent, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, director of elementary education, department coordinators, director of guidance, girls advisor, athletic director, para-professional staff, custodial and maintenance personnel, food service personnel, transportation department personnel, office clerical employees, supervisors and other personnel excluded by Section 4 of the Act
