AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed under Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act and Rule 4.6 of the Public Employment Relations Board's Rules and Regulations, the parties waived hearing and filed with the Public Employment Relations Board a stipulation of bargaining unit deleting the job classification of department coordinator from and adding the job classification of basic skills coordinator to the previously determined bargaining unit and deleting the job classification of Director of Curriculum from the list of exclusions from that unit.

Said stipulation having been tentatively approved by the Board and posted in conformance with the Board's Rules and Regulations, no objections having been filed hereby, and the Board having no objections:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the bargaining unit previously determined in Case No. 87 and the certification of the Saydel Education Association in that case be and thereto is amended to read as follows.

INCLUDED. Regular full-time and part-time certified classroom teachers, basic skills coordinator, nurses, athletic coaches and assistants, special education personnel, employed by the Saydel School District, including learning disabilities teachers and EMR teachers.

EXCLUDED. Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Director of Supportive Services, Building Principals, and vice-principals, confidential secretaries assigned to work with Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Director of Supportive Services, Principals, vice-principals, Board of Education, secretaries and clerks employed in the Central Administration office, teacher aides and associates, Custodial and Maintenance personnel, substitute teachers, interim teachers and all other personnel excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
