ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 27th day of June, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on May 30, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that the Washington Education Association, an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that the WASHINGTON EDUCATION ASSOCIATION should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Washington Community School District, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED All full-time and regular part-time classroom teachers, guidance counselors, librarians, nurses, special education teachers, reading consultants, and reading teachers

EXCLUDED Superintendents, administrative assistants, principals assistant principals (including those who have part-time teaching assignments), speech clinicians, school psychologists, teacher aides and associates, secretaries, study hall supervisors, food service supervisors and managers, cooks, custodians, maintenance personnel, bus mechanics, bus drivers, and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act
