- INCLUDED: All professional full-time and regular part-time employees, including classroom teachers, librarians, guidance counselors, special education teachers, and special teachers of music, physical education, art, and developmental reading.
- EXCLUDED: Secretaries and clerks, custodians, food service employees, transportation employees, nurse, maintenance personnel, para-professionals and educational aides, and employees of the alternative school, and all others not specifically designated above or as excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
