ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2) was conducted under the supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying CWA Local 7170 as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the certification of the Communication Workers of America, Local 7170 as the exclusive bargaining representative for certain employees of Central Rivers Area Education Agency, successor to the Area Education Agency 267, is hereby amended. The public employer will hereafter be identified as **"Central Rivers Area Education Agency."**


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second sentence of the first paragraph of the order issued in this matter reads as follows:


